

	1 Kings 19:11-12	Psalm 46
Wind	A great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but the LORD was not in the wind.	46:3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled.
	Wind = war – conflict among nations	Wind causes the waters to roar
Earthquake	After the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake.	46:3 Though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof.
	Earthquake = revolution – conflict among groups within nations	Wind leads directly into the earthquake.
Fire	After the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire.	46:2 Though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea The heathen raged, the kingdoms were
	Fire = anarchy - conflict among individuals.	moved: he uttered his voice*, the earth melted.
Voice	After the fire a still small voice* (voice of Eden) Voice = peace - ends all conflicts	46:10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.
