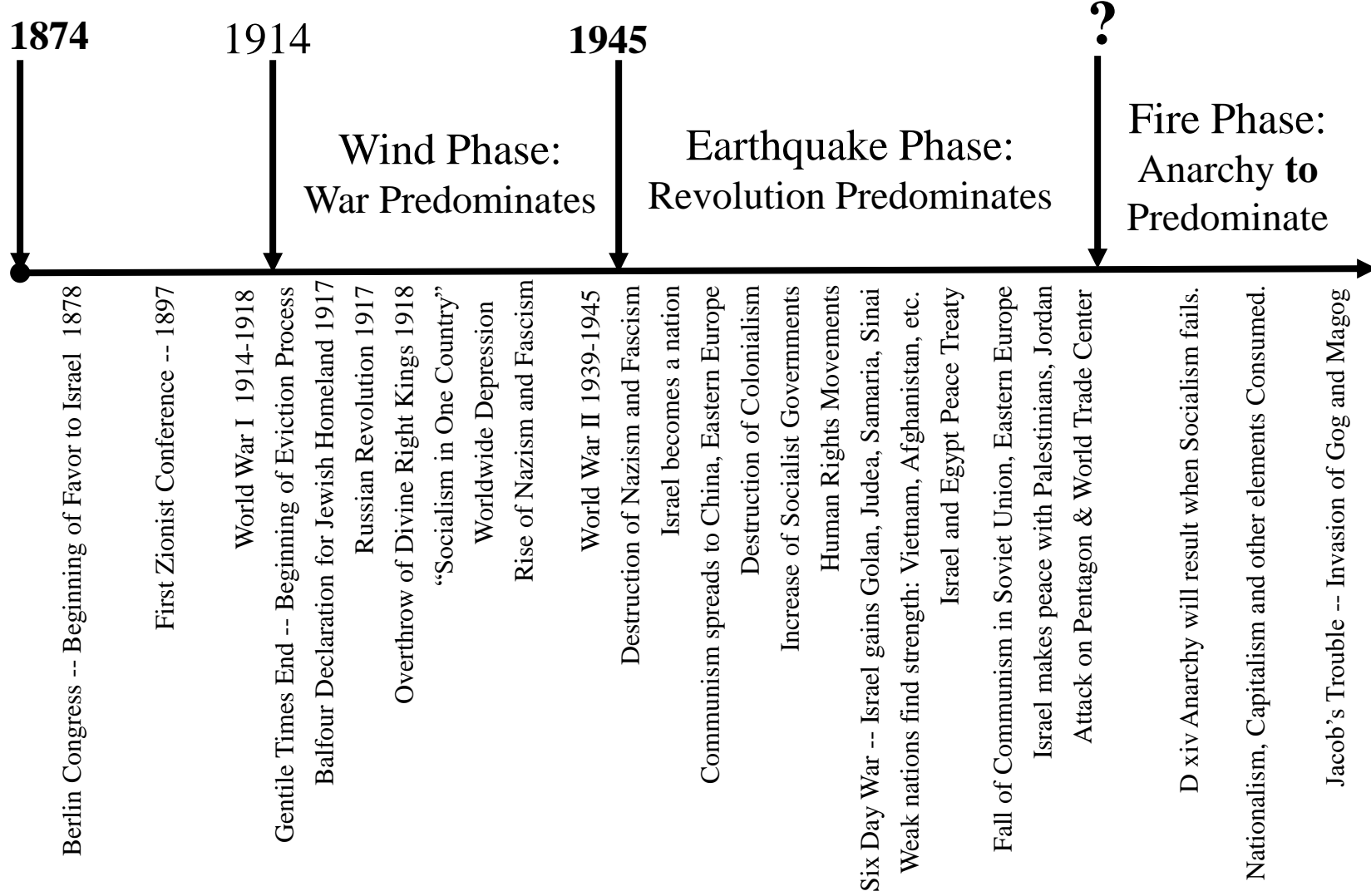

Still Small Voice - the Voice of Eden

Comparing Psalm 46 and 1 Kings 19

	1 Kings 19:11-12	Psalm 46
Wind	<p>A great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but the LORD was not in the wind.</p> <p><i>Wind = war – conflict among nations</i></p>	<p>46:3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled.</p> <p><i>Wind causes the waters to roar</i></p>
Earthquake	<p>After the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake.</p> <p><i>Earthquake = revolution – conflict among groups within nations</i></p>	<p>46:3 Though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof.</p> <p><i>Wind leads directly into the earthquake.</i></p>
Fire	<p>After the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire.</p> <p><i>Fire = anarchy – conflict among individuals.</i></p>	<p>46:2 Though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea . . . The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice*, the earth melted.</p>
Voice	<p>After the fire a still small voice* (<i>voice of Eden</i>)</p> <p><i>Voice = peace - ends all conflicts</i></p>	<p>46:10 Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.</p> <p><i>God's message of peace</i></p>

* God speaks peace to man after speaking to man in his wrath (Psalm 2:5 Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure. Joel 3:16 The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake. Heb 12:26 Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven.)
